

MyRepublic GAMER Arena 2019 Season 2 FIFA 19 Online Tournament Rules

These Tournament Rules apply in addition to the GAMER Arena Tournament Terms & Conditions.

1. Tournament Details

- a. Game: FIFA 19 (Online Tournament)
- b. Tournament Date: 13 April 2019, 11 May 2019, 8 June 2019
- c. Tournament Time: 12.00pm till end of tournament
- d. Reporting Time: 11.00am to 11.45am
- e. Registration Closing Date: Thursday, 6pm
- f. Tournament Location: Online PlayStation 4 console only
- g. Tournament Format: 1v1 Single Elimination Tournament
- h. Game Mode: Kick-off Mode
- 2. Gameplay Settings (Game settings will be set by the referees on event day)
 - a. Difficulty Level: Legendary
 - b. Half Length: 5 Minutes (For Group Stages) 6 minutes (For Knockout Round)
 - c. Injuries: On
 - d. Offsides: On
 - e. Time/Score Display: On
 - f. Camera: Tele Broadcast (Height: 20, Zoom: 0)
 - g. Radar: 2D or 3D
 - h. Volume Settings: Default
 - i. Controls: Tactical Defending
 - j. Timed Finishing: On

3. Knockout Stages

Home & Away: Players will have to play a game of 2 matches (away goal rules do not apply). If the score remains the same after 2 games, a 3rd game will be played with golden goal rules. If the 3rd game is complete as a tie, a penalty shootout will be conducted to determine the winner.

Time-wasting is strictly forbidden. Time-wasting includes passing the ball among your defenders in your own half only during the last few minutes.

Custom formations are not permitted. Custom tactics are allowed.

A pause can only be made at the following scenarios:

- a. When the ball is out of play (Throw-in/ Free Kicks/ Corners/ Kick-off)
- b. Half Time
- c. When a player is injured and unable to carry on with the game

A warning will be given to players caught pausing while the game is in play.

4. General Rules

- a. Players may not select any fictional All-Star teams (e.g. Classic 11).
- b. Any action designed to disrupt the opposing Player's view of the field or ability to select controlled players is prohibited.
- c. Each game will begin play once both players are ready. All players will need to be on <u>MyRepublic GAMER Arena Discord</u> to communicate with their opponents
- d. Players not present at the designated start time for any match will be disqualified, and their opponent shall be granted a 3-0 score. Players are encouraged to be in the designated play area 15-minutes prior to game time.
- e. Players shall be responsible for keeping track of the game situation. If a game is interrupted, the situation can be restored. In all situations possible, tournament referees will monitor the game situation so that it may be restored in the event of game interruptions.
- f. No game interruptions will be allowed, except designated pauses to report scores (if any).
- g. Only players are allowed in the tournament area during their matches. If a player is not playing, he/she will be not be allowed in the tournament area.
- h. Players are not allowed to warm-up or use the consoles at any point of time if they do not have a game to play.
- i. Players will be given a 10 minutes grace period if their match is next.
- j. If the player is not present after 10 minutes, it will result in a disqualification.
- k. Should there be any disputes, players are to pause the game when the ball is out of play and inform the marshal on site immediately.
- I. No refunds will be given should there be any walkovers or disqualifications.

5. Game Interruptions

- a. If a game is interrupted intentionally by any Player, the Player will be disqualified immediately.
- b. If a game interruption is caused by outside circumstances such as a machine error or loss of power, the game shall be continued from the point of interruption.
- c. If a game disconnects, please start a new game and play the remaining time left. The score will remain the same before the game disconnects.
